Lithium Corporation Properties

Fish Lake Valley

- Lithium Enriched Salt Pan
- Mining claims that cover approximately 6400 acres.
- Preliminary sampling indicates that surficial Lithium enrichment has been found that is on par to that seen at Silver Peak—the only lithium carbonate brine producing plant in North America.

Salt Wells

- Lithium Enriched Salt Pan
- 12,320 acre parcel that covers the Eightmile Basin, a playa, which lies approximately 15 miles to the southeast of Fallon, the county seat of Churchill County, Nevada.
- Exploratory sediment sampling of the playa was conducted in the summer and fall of 2009 and 83% of the samples taken within the claim area to date have returned anomalous values in Lithium, with the highest value being in the order of 750 ppm Li.
